

ESTES PARK GUN & ARCHERY CLUB: 2013 Cleanup Day Report.

The year 2013 saw eight (8) scheduled cleanup days for both the Indoor Range and the Outdoor Range. Of these eight (8), one was cancelled on 09-14-13 due to the flood event.

Totals for 2013:

- Number of workers: 167
- Hours Worked: 473
- Average Working Time: 2.83 hours

Recycle Efforts for Lead and Brass: \$234.12 (*late summer/fall recycle did not occur due to flood*)

Indoor Range Cleanup & Repairs:

- New HEPA vacuum purchased for floor cleaning
- Exterior vents repaired
- New sump pumps installed, lines rerouted
- Gutters repaired
- Outside litter removal
- Lead mined
- Target stands repaired
- Walls painted, touched up

Outdoor Range Cleanup & Repairs:

- Lead mined
- Brass reclaimed

- Backstops repaired
- Roadside and range mowing, weed trimming, tree branch trimming
- General litter pickup
- 25 yard pistol range target stands (approx. 30) built or repaired
- 25 yard pistol range, target sockets repaired or replaced
- Rifle range target stands repaired
- All tables & benches scraped, primed & painted
- Archery range targets repaired
- Archery range trail improved for footing and cleared of brush
- Vault toilet cleaned

Other scheduled maintenance including the recycling of stored lead and brass did not occur due to the flood that damaged the outdoor range bridge & road and prevented access to the area.
