

Clean-up Report for the April 16th, 2011 clean-up at the Indoor Range

On April 16th, 2011 we had our first clean-up for the year. We had 17 people in attendance and generated a total of 35 hours and 30 minutes of worked time.

On the day we accomplished the following items:

- Mined 7 buckets of lead from the backstop
- Sorted 3 buckets of shells into recyclable categories
- Put up a new broom and shovel holder
- Vacuumed the entire floor of the Indoor Range
- Policed up all trash that had blown in around the outside of the range
- Dug a trench for the new gas line from the propane tank to the building
- Leveled out the placement of the Port-O-Let toilet
- Built new sifters for sorting shells and lead at future clean-ups

Two of the buckets of lead went home with club members for smelting and being recast as new bullets and the other five buckets will be resorted and recycled at our next clean-up day.
