The Club's membership was notified by email, announcing their last chance for a clean-up day credit, over 185 members. With the weather planning to be good, Bill Conger & Sharyn Gartner chose to be leaders at both ranges, Outdoor & Indoor respectively.

Workers were split to finish finalizing the Outdoor Range with:

- Repairing Rifle Range target holders
- Clean-up & lead recycling at the 25 yard pistol range
- Shored up Noels Draw Creek for the next Spring snow melt

The Indoor Range workers completed many projects:

- Sifting backstop sand and removal of lead
- Maintenance to the two sump-pumps & adding covers
- Hepa Filter vacuuming of entire range
- PVC pipe stand alone target holders repaired
- Three tables of lead & cartridge sorters to prepare for recycling
- General cleaning of walk-in area
- Trash policing around the outside of building
- Rain gutter maintenance & cleaning
- Trimming of shrubs around propane tank & building
- Light blub replacement for outdoor lighting

Attendees numbered 41 working 99 hours toward their individual clean-up credits. The Club will try for one more special clean-up to paint the interior walls of the Indoor Range. Several (18) members responded to a future scheduled work day and they will be notified. Special note is to be made: members that do not attend a clean-up day are billed \$50 for non-participation at membership renewal time in January.
