#### Clean-up Projects

- 1. Sifting & Removal of lead from backstop area
- 2. Rebuilding & Making new free standing 3/4"PVC target stands
- 3. General cleaning inside the building
  - a. Vaccum floor
  - b. Inspect Sump-Pumps
- 4. Clean-up outside building
  - a. 2"PVC drainage pipe improvement-paint
  - b. Policing grounds for trash

**Needs:** Large containers of water: Club has 4 – 5 gallon water containers but more water will be needed.

Loaner hacksaw to cut 2" PVC pipe

**Bring:** Your gloves, shovel or rake and/or tools you think we might use. Wear old clothes or coveralls, to have clean clothes to drive home in. (precaution for any lead dust gathered on fabric) Old rags for dusting cabinets & chairs that can be thrown out after project is done. When you get home, wash your clothes and take a shower & wash your hair.

Next Clean-up Day, May 16<sup>th</sup>, was scheduled for the Outdoor Range. According to the timeline for the Estes Valley Recreation & Park District for the rebuilding of Noels Draw Lane will not be completed by that time.
